

Ambulance cover

If you don't have private health insurance, you will be required to purchase a full 12 months of emergency ambulance cover**. **BUPA** is the most affordable for ambulance cover*.

Restricted Medication

Most **opioid** and **benzodiazepine**-based medications are restricted at our Therapeutic Communities*. Please let your counsellor know what medications you are on at the time of your assessment. Please note that we do not have Psychologists/ Psychiatrists on site, however we do have a local GP attend the site each week.

*Medication exemptions can be made on a case-by-case basis.
